



Volunteer Roles Job Descriptions

Ambassador Program – If you have a keen interest in supporting the success of Play On! this year and into the future or if you are active in your community or have connections in any related sport; we want you on our Play On! Team.

Check In – Assisting teams and volunteers upon arrival at the event with accreditation, working materials, and being an overall cheerleader for our morning crew!

Equipment Manager - Play On! Canada provides use of goalie equipment to all participants who do not have their own goalie gear. You will be provided a sign in & sign out sheet to manage tracking of gear.

Event Set Up (Friday) – General set up of the event, such as building rinks, securing fencing, hanging banners and/or setting up fencing and sound equipment. Ability to lift heavy items may be required.

Event Tear Down (Sunday) – Clean-up of the event. Begins early afternoon on Sunday.

Green Team – Ensure the event site is clean and green from garbage and recyclables.

Hydration Station – Assisting at the water station, refilling water coolers.

Master Scoreboard – Posting game scores and answering general questions about the event. Managing the lost & found.

Pre-Event Promotion – Can you hang posters in your community? Some location ideas (i.e., the local gym or hockey rink?). If yes, we want to hear from you!

Prizing - Sunday only. Award championship medals to the winning teams.

Rink Monitor – You will be in a section of rinks to oversee games and procedures. Assist officials and scorekeeper. Knowledge of Play On! rules required. Rules are [here](#).

Runner – You must possess a willingness to run! Balls and various items will need to be delivered to rinks throughout the tournament. It will be your job to deliver them!

Score Keeper – This will be a very important role this year! You will be responsible for accurately keeping score on an electronic tablet. Keen eyesight and general knowledge of Play On! rules will assist you in this role. Rules are [here](#). The tournament will require one score keeper at every rink for every shift. Security – Monitor event site to ensure safety for all participants, spectators, officials, and volunteers.

Traffic Control – Assist in parking area for all participants, spectators, officials, and volunteers.
